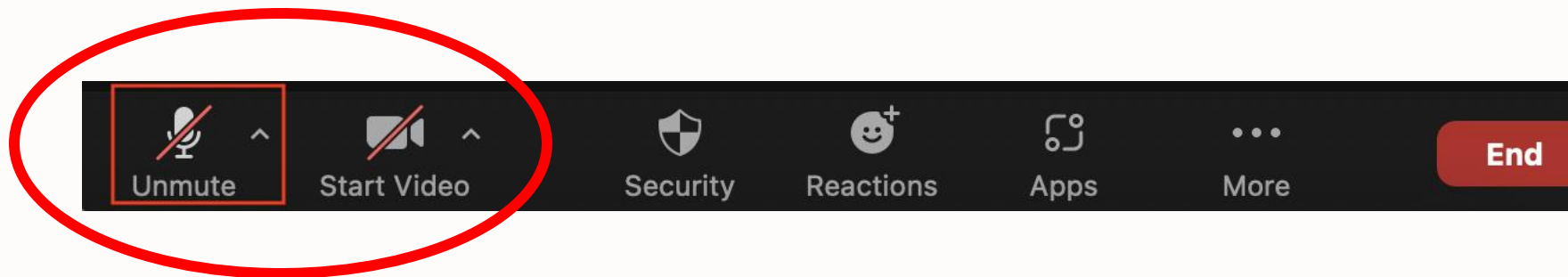

- Promote readiness for Enhanced Care Management (ECM) and Community Supports services among managed care plans, providers, CBOs, county agencies, public hospitals, tribes, and others in the region.

# PHIL as CPI Facilitator

- Convene and engage a diverse set of stakeholders associated with the implementation of CalAIM.
- Conduct outreach to organizations that serve historically marginalized populations and others to actively participate in collaborative planning groups.
- Identify potential resolution strategies and tactics to overcome challenges and conflicts.
- ➔ • Facilitate comprehensive programming (e.g., webinars, in-person convenings, etc.) that allow for robust collaboration amongst participants.

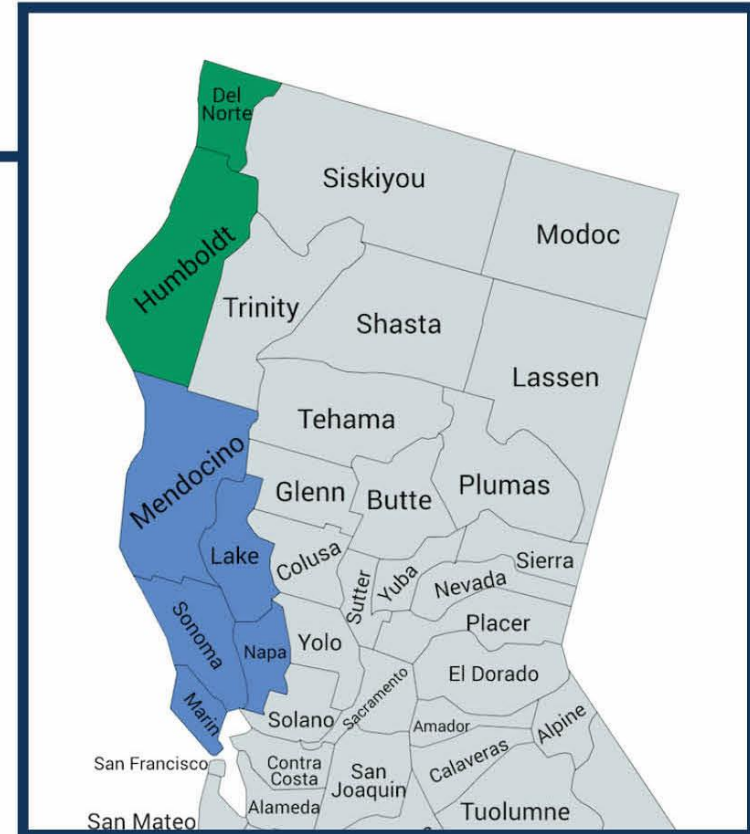
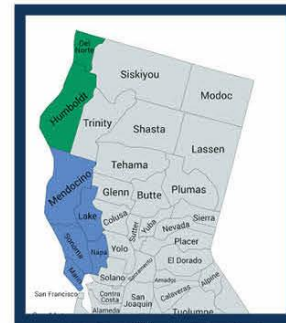
