| Partnership HealthPlan Presents- ECM Population of Focus Spotlight: Birth Equity & Justice | Key Themes: PHC explained that the birth equity population is for pregnant or postpartum adults and youth of African American, Native American, or Pacific Islander race, and that Partnership is still looking to expand their provider network for this population. She also provides examples of how ECM providers and lead care managers can serve this population of focus. Additionally, PHC provided an overview of the Justice Involved Initiative and the ECM Benefit, which will offer Medi-Cal services to justice-involved individuals. The initiative will be divided into two parts, with the ECM benefit focusing on individuals transitioning from incarceration and the pre-release services targeting justice-involved individuals while they are incarcerated. The eligibility criteria for both populations of focus are outlined, and the requirements for ECM providers are discussed. | Next Steps: PHIL will coordinate with PHC to learn how to support local expansion of new Populations of Focus. | Referral pathways remain complex and central to confusion.
